

Vocational openings for USI graduates

2008 Survey

USI

Methodology used

- Survey carried out in April 2008 by USI's Stage&Placement office on class 2002 and class 2006-2007 graduates from the Economics, Communication Sciences, Architecture and Informatics faculties.
- ⇒ 873 graduates contacted, 449 answers received (51.4%), of which 132 from class 2002 graduates (58.6%) and 317 from class 2006-2007 graduates (48.9%).

The main results of the survey

- The percentage of students occupied is 95.3% 1 year from graduation and rises to 97.8% 5 years from graduation.
- ⇒ The average time taken to find employment is 1.5 months.
- Mobility increases as professional experience is gained: 1 year after graduation 66.7% of graduates work in Ticino while after 5 years this percentage drops to 56.9%.
- → A growing number of alumni hold top positions: 5 years after graduation 1 graduate in 5 holds a managerial/executive position.


The employment situation 1 year after graduation

- ⇒ 95.3% of graduates are employed: of these 71.3% work, 21.5% study and 2.5% have made other choices.
- 2 4.7% (15) graduates are job-hunting: of these 46.3% hold a Bachelor's degree and 73.3% have already had work experience.


The employment situation 5 years after graduation

- ⇒ 97.8% of graduates are employed: of these 90.9 % work, 0.8 % study and 6.1 % have made other choices
- 2.3% (3) of graduates are job-hunting: of these two are from Ticino and are looking mainly in Ticino; their age is 32/33.


⇒ Employment by sector, graduates in Economics




⇒Employment by sector, graduates in Communication Sciences



⇒Employment by sector, graduates in Architecture




⇒ Employment by sector, graduates in Informatics




Place of work (1 year after graduation)

Prevalence of vocational openings in Ticino




Place of work (5 years after graduation)

Greater mobility outside Ticino (mainly to other cantons)




Size of the company (1 year after graduation)

⇒ Slight trend to leave large companies for medium-sized ones (26-100)



Type of contract (1 year after graduation)

- ⇒ Most USI graduates have an employee (89.2%) and open- ended contract (63.7%).
- ⇒ 71.6% choose to work full-time.

Type of contract (5 years after graduation)

- The number of graduates with open-ended contracts has increased (89.7%).
- ⇒ 75% continue to choose to work full-time (compared to 71% of class 2006-2007 graduates).

Consistency, professional satisfaction and USI

- ⇒ 72.2% of the graduates who answered work in a sector which is consistent with the training received at USI and 94.9% declare to be satisfied with their current job. 5 years after graduation these percentages rise to 75.7% (consistency) and 96.2% (satisfaction) respectively.
- Of those who answered the questionnaire, 91.3% of class 2006-2007 graduates and 87.8% of class 2002 graduates declare that they are satisfied with the skills acquired at USI.
