CAS Gynecological cancers (CAS-Gyn)

Duration: 17 months

Degree: Certificate of Advanced Studies USI in Gynecological cancer (CAS-Gyn)

Description: The program focuses on advancing the knowledge and science in the management of patients affected by gyneacological cancers.

This program, which is offered on a part-time basis over 17 months, consists of 3 in-presence seminars and 6 online modules.

Upon successful completion of the program and after passing the final exam, participants obtain an academic certificate issued by the European School of Oncology (ESO) and the Università della Svizzera Italiana assigning 14 European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System Points (ECTS) and equaling a work load of 381 didactic hours and a diploma supplement issued by the Università della Svizzera Italiana.

Target: The program is designed for medical doctors (medical oncology, radiation oncology, radiology, nuclear medicine or pathology), and surgeons who are engaged in the field of oncology and/or gynaecology, especially in the field of gynaecological cancers.

Admission: Admission to the Certificate of Advanced Studies in Gynecological cancer program is by competitive application only. The selection is based on eligibility criteria and on a selection procedure (decisions on admissions are made by the appointed Program Chair). Attendance is limited to 25 participants.

Attendance: To obtain the Certificate of Advanced Studies in Gynecological cancer, participants must attend all seminars and modules according to the provided timeline.

Fees: The tuition fee is EUR 5,400. A discounted fee of EUR 3,000 is made available to participants from low, lower middle and upper middle-income economies as defined by The World Bank for the year 2022.
