What is it a curricular internship?

The term 'internship' (in French 'stage') commonly refers to practical training pursued by students nearing graduation and new graduates in a vocational context.

The main objectives of an internship are

- To acquaint students with the business world;
- To identify concrete possibilities for employment in a given professional role and to direct the application dossier towards specific career opportunities.

Curricular internships are mandatory or optional within a Bachelor's or Master's programme. They award ECTS credits towards completion of the degree.

The rules of the Curricular Internship at USI

Is the curricular internship planned in my study programme?

At USI, the curricular internship is regulated by the Curricular Internship Guidelines, approved by the Faculty Councils (Economics and Communication), which can be found here: www.desk.usi.ch/en/curricular-internship-guidelines

The required documentation

What are the regulations for doing a curricular internship in Switzerland and abroad?

Internship in Switzerland

- Change of the study permit
- With a "B" (Student) Permit issued in Ticino, international / overseas students are entitled to undertake a curricular internship (if mandatory) in Switzerland only by requesting a change of the permit to the Immigration Office (in the Canton where the internship will be carried out). In order to ask for a change of the permit for an internship to the Immigration Office you have to submit:
- USI Career Service support letter.
- Online Form for change of permit on the Immigration Office website.

Internship abroad

• Internship Agreement
In some European Countries, the law requires an internship
agreement signed by both the employer and the university.
Ask the Career Service for this agreement if your employers
does not provide one for you.

Work Permit

In other Countries, a work permit is required to do an internship. Check if your destination does require it on the Federal Department of Foreign Affairs (FDFA) website. The hosting employer is responsible for your work permit.

How to find an internship and grants for internship abroad

How do I find an internship?

It is sole responsibility of each individual student to find his/her internship; this generally involves three main steeps:

- Identifying the desired or suitable sector and role
- Finding out employers and related application procedures
- Preparing the required documentations (CV, motivation letter, other relevant documents)

How can we – as Career Service support your internship search?

- An online Job Bank
- A weekly Career Newsletter
- Workshops, meetings and events with companies
- internship search? One to one professional counselling and cv checks
 - Drafting of cover letter (Italian and English)
 - Internship agreements with companies
 - Scholarship for internship abroad

How can I apply for and obtain an internship abroad grant? To encourage professional mobility, the Swiss Confederation and the Career Service provide scholarships for conducting an internship in Europe or around the world (SEMP scholarship).

Registration and validation of a curricular internship (ECTS)

How do I validate my curricular internship?

Pre-Internship (Registration)

- Fill out the online internship registration form on the career website
- Download it and submit it to the Academic Tutor (the Master's Director and/or his/her delegate(s) for Master Degrees and the Delegato per gli esami for the Bachelor in Economics) for approval
- 3. Upload the approval online on your Online internship dossier
- 4. Upload on your Online internship dossier copy of your internship contract

NB: If your internship requires a permit modification or internship agreement, you can download the necessary documentation directly online, on your internship profile.

Post-stage (Validation)

- Fill out the internship final form online on your Online internship dossier
- 2. Download it and request the approval of your Academic tutor.
- 3. Upload / fill out on the USI CareerGate your most updated CV, which must include the work experience you would like to validate as curricular internship
- 4. Upload on your Online internship dossier:
- end of internship certificate, signed by your employer
- internship final form approved and signed by your Academic Tutor
- copy of your CV (with the work experience you want to validate).
