

ISFI's specific terms and conditions for FTL scholarships

Specific terms and conditions for curricula run by the Istituto di Studi Filosofici at the Facoltà di Teologia di Lugano:

Please note that:

- The decision of the Scholarship Review Committee shall reflect any other scholarship granted to the student. In addition, the student shall promptly inform the Committee if he/she is granted any other scholarship before being notified of the decision about the FTL subsidy.
- If, at the time of submitting the application, the student is still waiting for the review of any documents which he/she has already submitted and which are needed to be eligible for the scholarship, the student shall notify such circumstance in the cover letter. However, admissions will only be decided after checking if the student has earned all the required credits on the portal.

Specific terms and conditions for BAF scholarships

- Applications for scholarships may only be submitted for the official term of the Bachelor's programme (based on the Bologna System – 6 semesters). Students who have not passed all their exams within the prescribed time may not apply.
- BAF scholarships are annual.
- Scholarships may not be granted in the second year of a specialisation course at the Faculty of Communication Sciences, Culture and Society, at the Faculty of Economic Sciences or at the Faculty of Informatics at Università della Svizzera Italiana. Exceptions may be made by the Scholarship Review Committee.

Requirements for renewal of scholarship

Students who wish to apply for a scholarship for the following year must earn at least 30 ECTSs per year and have a weighted mean score of 8.5/10 or higher.

Requirements for application as from the second year of the Bachelor's programme

Students enrolled in the Bachelor's programme who wish to apply for an initial scholarship must have earned at least 15 ECTSs per semester of Bachelor's enrolment and have a weighted mean score of 8.5/10 or higher.

The invoice sent to the student for the six-monthly fees does not reflect any scholarship granted. Students who are granted a scholarship shall only pay their dues, i.e. based on the scholarship granted.



Specific terms and conditions for MAP scholarships

- Applications for financial support may only be submitted for the official term of the Master's programme (based on the Bologna System – 4 semesters). Students who have not passed all their exams within the prescribed time may not apply.
- Financial aid for ISFI is non-cumulative with any scholarship for the subsidised semester or for the following semester.

Requirements for MAP scholarship application and renewal

1st semester of enrolment

- the student must meet all the entry requirements for the Master's programme (Bachelor's programme and B2+ English level) by the submission deadline.
- the scholarship is awarded per semester.

2nd semester

- in the previous semester, the student must have earned the 30 ECTSs required for the curriculum and have a weighted mean score of 9/10 or higher.
- the scholarship is awarded per semester.

3rd and 4th semesters of enrolment

- in the previous semester, the student must have earned the 60 ECTSs required for the curriculum and have a weighted mean score of 9/10 or higher.
- the scholarship is annual.

The invoice sent to the student for the six-monthly fees does not reflect any scholarship granted. Students who are granted a scholarship shall only pay their dues, i.e. based on the scholarship granted.
