Language of Instruction	<p>German and English</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In general, the language of instruction is German. Most study programs offered at Ulm University are German-taught programs. However, there may be select courses taught in English even in German study programs. In addition, there is a growing number of Master programs taught in English.• Medicine and Dentistry are strictly taught in German (including exams or clinical electives).• Students wishing to do a project or thesis in any of the other subject areas do not need to prove proficiency in German, as long as they have sufficient command of English.
Courses from other departments and faculties	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students are expected to choose the majority of their courses and/or credits in that subject area which is covered by the inter-institutional agreement. They may choose up to two courses from other study programmes offered by the same faculty.• In addition, students may sign up for language courses (German and other languages).• Courses from career-integrated programmes or the continuing professional education programmes offered by the School of Advanced Professional Studies (SAPS) are not open to Erasmus+ students.• In order to take courses from Master programs, students must have Master level, i.e. they must have either completed a Bachelor degree or an equivalent of ~180 ECTS at the beginning of their Erasmus+ mobility (~150 ECTS at the time of application).• Students wishing to do lab work may have to attend a safety briefing prior to the start of the lab. Approval may be denied or withdrawn if the performance of the student raises serious doubts that s/he will be able to follow or react to instructions due to poor linguistic competence and/or academic preparation in order to avoid hazards.

Language Requirements (at the time of application)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We expect students to have at least level B1 in the language of instruction. • Students wishing to do a project or thesis must have at least level B1 in English. • To prove that they have sufficient command in the respective language(s), students must submit a Certificate of Language Proficiency with their application. If students wish to take classes in both, English and German, both languages must be certified. • Students who have only level A2 in German at the time of application may be accepted under the condition that they participate in the Intensive German Language Course prior to the beginning of their studies (September / March) • Students wishing to do practical work in a hospital (elective/clerkship/rotation) should have at least level B2 in German.
Learning Agreements	Students should not send an Erasmus+ learning agreement with their application. Instead, they should fill out our Study Proposal form, listing all the courses they are interested in. If they are accepted, they receive feedback on these courses, based on which they can make out a learning agreement.
